

Keeping Card Secure

A credit card is an easy and convenient way to buy now and pay later. But it's always good to be aware of credit card security to protect yourself from fraud.

How fraud happens:

- Lost credit card
- Identify theft on credit card applications or existing account takeovers
- Card skimming
- Phishing (email), smishing (SMS), and vishing (call)

How credit cards provide protection:

- Card Verification Value (CVV)
- Multi-factor authentication
- Fraud monitoring system
- Purchase Protect Insurance with your HSBC Credit Cards

Protect yourself from fraud:

- Keep your personal and account info confidential
- Never share your One-Time Password (OTP) with anyone
- Make sure that messages received from the bank are official and legitimate
- Beware of phishing websites, emails, SMS or calls asking for your card details
- Always verify if the sellers you deal with are legitimate
- Don't shop using public Wi-Fi
- Shred your old statements and personal documents properly
- Cut across your old card's EMV chip and magnetic strip and throw the pieces separately
