



Romance Scam

Scammers can use fake identities to spark up romance and gain your trust. They can even try to emotionally manipulate you into sending them money or disclosing your personal and account details.

Watch out for these red flags:

- Someone you've recently met quickly professes feelings for you.
- Online profile seems too good to be true or not consistent with what they tell you.
- Comes up with excuses to avoid meeting you or doing video calls.
- Asks for help claiming financial, health, or emergency crisis.
- Guilt trips you to follow their orders and send them money.
- Pressures you to give your bank account details.

Protect yourself:

- Don't overshare your personal details on dating sites or to someone you've only chatted with online.
- Don't blindly trust information they provide.
- Don't reveal anything about your finances.
- Never send money or give card and bank account details, ATM card, or copies of personal documents to someone you haven't met or you do not completely know.
