



Now, moving money is even easier with HSBC Online Banking. From paying bills to transferring funds, it's simple. Between your accounts and your own country and then the same currency, easy. There's quick move money.

To begin, just choose which of your accounts you're moving money from. Then select where you want your money to go, and how much you want to transfer. And you're set!

Setting up a new transfer or paying your bills? Both are easy. Go to my accounts and choose which of your accounts you're moving money from. Then click move money. Under my payees, you can easily search for payees you've saved in the past, or you can set up a new payee by selecting the "new payee" tab. Select person if you're transferring to an account from a local or international bank. Here, you can also make any type of payment to local or international bank accounts, of companies not in the list of HSBC Online Banking bill payment merchants. If you are paying your bills through HSBC's Online Bills payment merchants, then select company. First, let's try making a payment to another person. You're already set up for local transfers in your home country by default. Start by selecting your payee's account type. Then enter your payee's account currency and account number. Other details will be asked, depending on your payee's account type. You can also make international transfers by changing your payee's bank country and completing the relevant details. When you're done with your payee's bank details, you can enter and save your payee's name for easy reference in the future.

Next, decide how much you want to transfer and note why you're making the transfer. Are you transferring now, or on a future date? Maybe it's a recurring transfer, so you prefer fixed amounts on a day and frequency of your choice. Enter the transaction security code generated using your Secure Key. And that's all the details you'll need to input. Now, just check that everything's the way you want it. Confirm your transaction, and you're done.

Now, let's try paying bills. Begin by making a new transaction. This time, select company. You could enter or search for the company you're paying, and indicate the company reference number. The rest of the details are straightforward. Fill them in, confirm everything is correct, and you're done! Once you've set up your transfer or payments, you can easily go back to your saved payees and future dated transactions. So the next time you pay or transfer, we can easily help you search for them.
